



## FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION PRIOR AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENT

Federal campaign finance law requires the American Hospital Association Political Action Committee (AHAPAC) and the Nebraska Hospital Association Political Action Committee (NHA PAC), acting on its behalf, to have prior authorization from the hospital CEO or other qualified hospital representative before solicitation of eligible employees of the hospital occurs.

Under federal law, once the Prior Authorization card is signed, individuals may be asked to contribute to AHAPAC if they fall into both of the following categories:

- 1) salaried employees of a member hospital, and
- 2) supervisory, managerial/administrative positions with professional responsibilities.

Please be aware that certain state and federal election laws may differ, with state laws being less restrictive in certain areas. If specific questions arise, it may be useful to contact an attorney.
