

### Indication(s) For Foley Catheter

- Patient Does Not Have Indwelling Urinary Catheter
- Urinary Retention
- Accurate Measurement of Output - Pt unable to use urinal or bedpan
- Less than 48 hours post urologic surgery
- Less than 24 hours post nonurologic surgery
- Open Wound (level 3 or 4 Ulcer) in Sacral or Perineal Area in Incontinent Patient
- Prolonged Immobilization (pelvic fracture, potentially unstable thoracic or lumbar spine injury)
- Patient too ill or Fatigued to use any other type of Urinary Collection Strategy
- Family Request
- Patient Currently has Suprapubic Urinary Catheter
