



PATIENT-CENTERED MENTAL HEALTH IN PEDIATRIC PRIMARY CARE PROGRAM

In response to the increasing need for pediatric mental health care, Children's Hospital & Medical Center is partnering with The REACH Institute to offer a learning opportunity to primary care providers serving children in Nebraska. The "Patient-Centered Mental Health in Pediatric Primary Care Program" (PPP) is a nationally recognized and evidence-based training that provides information and tools for screening, treatment, and management of mental health conditions in children and adolescents.

Registration for the 17.75 hour virtual training is free and CMEs will be awarded upon completion. The training also includes a six-month case-based follow up program. 12 twice-monthly, one-hour collaborative learning calls with the REACH Institute training staff will follow the initial training and additional CMEs will be awarded.
