### OVERVIEW

The United States Pharmacopeia (USP) is a compendium for drug information that sets the standards for drugs in the United States. USP Chapter 800, Hazardous Drugs-Handling in the Healthcare Setting, specifically addresses the safe handling of hazardous drugs to promote patient and worker safety as well as environmental protection. This webinar will discuss the major components of USP 800, such as engineering controls, personal protective equipment (PPE), and ongoing training and monitoring of staff and facilities. Additionally, it will examine how USP 800 will impact hospitals across the country.

2. Discuss the financial and operational impact USP 800 will have on hospitals.
3. Prepare a plan to be in compliance with the regulations including implementation, personal training and compliance monitoring.
